Developed as a celebration of New Zealand's iconic beauty, the Te Araroa, Maori for the "long pathway" is a 3,000 kilometer (1860 miles) thru-hike across the north and south Island. In Marlborough, the trail traverses the Wairau River Valley into the steep slopes of the Kaikoura Ranges. Our Sauvignon Blanc is a tribute to this distinct terroir that make up the Marlborough growing region.

### WINE TASTING NOTES:

Fine notes of key lime, passionfruit, grapefruit, white flowers, and a stoney minerality on this wine.
