

Production Region: The Alexander Valley is nestled in the Mayacamas Mountains, the warmest AVA within Sonoma County, where the soil is comprised of prehistoric sea beds and volcanic rock. The vineyards sit on calcium rich, southern facing slopes which provide excellent drainage, paramount to the elegance of Alexander Valley wines. The summers are warm to hot, with cooling marine air, followed by moderately cool and wet winters.

Vinification: Aged in 3rd use American Oak barrels for 8-12 months

Aromas & Flavors: Cherry, Wild Blackberries, Cassis, Dried Herbs, Tobacco, and Cocoa

Structure: Deep Color, Full Bodied, Bold Tannin, Medium Acidity

Food Pairing: Red Meats, BBQ, Pork Roast, and Grilled Bell Peppers
