Dos Familias Winery is owned and operated by the Colombi

family, a group of mutli-generation wine makers. In 1861, the main building of the winery was constructed which was originally used as a wheat mill and currently is the winery's museum. By 1894, the property was converted to a vineyard and wine making facility. The Colombi family restored and updated the winery in 2002, combining the large 19th century buildings with 21st century technology. To this day the original building stands as one of the oldest wine-making facilities in Mendoza. The Colombi family's respect for the land translates into their vineyard management and winemaking. Their methods include hand harvesting, hand sorting, and treating the grapes with the utmost respect from planting to fermentation and finishing.

Origin: Mendoza, Argentina Varietal/s: Malbec

Production Region: The vineyards at Lujan de Cuyo, are located at the foot of the Andes mountain range, 1050 meters above sea level. Its dry, cool climate helps the grapes ripen slowly. The grapes are manually selected and sorted.

Vinification: After hand harvesting and sorting of the grapes, they are pressed and fermented. Aged in second and third use French Oak Barrels for 12 months then aged in bottle for 12 months.

Aging Potential: 6-10 years **ABV:** 14%

Closure: Cork
